Picture a horse drawn carriage carrying the bride to a ceremony on a beach. Exchanging vows with miles of Lake of the Ozarks as your backdrop. Or having an after-party on-board a 80 foot yacht.

Having a wedding at the Lake can include any number of elements and unique experiences. From the castle ruins at Ha Ha Tonka to lesser-known places to tie-the-knot, here is our list of unique places to get married at Lake of the Ozarks.

The Concrete House

Known by locals as Edgewater Estate, this 10,000 square-foot lakeside home is high on our list of places to have an intimate wedding. A ceremony can be held on the grassy roof overlooking the main channel with miles of views including the Community Bridge. The Frank Lloyd Wright inspired home is built into the side of the bluff and is made up of 2,911 yards of concrete. There is almost 5,000 square foot of decks to enjoy the scenery. Inside, you will find modern decor and custom-made furnishings. In addition to weddings, the home is rented out as a vacation or corporate retreat. Once the ceremony is over, up to 20 guests can stay overnight and enjoy the outdoor pool, tennis court, putting green and commercial kitchen. info@ozarkconcretehouse.com

Tan-Tar-A Chapel

Next to the waterpark and right off the miniature golf course is a tiny chapel at Tan-Tar-A that will provide a romantic setting. An added benefit, you don't have to go far to move the party inside for the reception. www.tan-tar-a.com

Japanese Gardens

Dedicated in 1989, the Japanese Gardens at Lodge of Four Seasons houses a rare collection of plants and trees. Holding a ceremony on the bridge over the pond will no doubt make a memorable day for everyone. Up to 200 guests will be able to look out over the Lake, enjoy the waterfalls and see the Koi in the ponds. www.4seasonsresort.com

On the beach

Willmore Lodge
